### Volunteer Description

#### Brief Description

Enjoy the Port of Everett Farmers Market, *and* help increase access to nutritious food in our community. Pickup surplus produce upon completion of the Farmers Market, and deliver the produce to Snohomish County Food Bank Distribution Center, located in Everett. This is a five month position.

#### Purpose of Assignment

Supply food bank clients with fresh produce.

#### Outline of Responsibilities

- Arrive 20 minutes before end of farmers market
- Load produce donations from local farmers into your vehicle
- Transport produce to Snohomish County Food Bank Distribution Center

#### Skills or Qualifications

- Ability to physically lift up to 40lbs
- Drivers license
- Must be willing to use personal vehicle for transport of produce

#### Benefits

- Promote food security and health in your community
- Learn about local agriculture
- Have fun and meet people!

#### Training and Support

Training will be required before starting volunteer commitment.

#### Time Commitment

Market takes place on Sundays between May 10th and October 18th. Volunteer will be required to pick up produce at 3:40pm on Sundays.
